STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section forey-eight of Chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to hunting on Kineo Point, in Kineo, in the County of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-eight of chapter thirty-two of the revised

- 2 statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of
- 3 the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, is hereby
- 4 amended by striking out all of said section and by substi-
- 5 tuting therefor the following section:

'Sect. 48. No person shall at any time hunt, pursue, shoot 7 at or kill any wild animal or bird on Kineo Point, in Kineo. 8 in the County of Piscataquis. Whoever violates this secgotion shall pay a fine of fifty dollars and costs for each offense."
