STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, to provide for the construction and equipment of a central school building at the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell the sum of thirty thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen and the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen; said sums to be expended under the direction of the trustees of juvenile institutions for the construction and equipment of a central school building at the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell.
