RESOLVE, In Favor of the State School for Boys at South Portland for General Maintenance.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated for the  
2 State School for Boys at South Portland, the sum of Thirty-  
3 eight Thousand Dollars for the year nineteen hundred fif-  
4 teen, and the sum of Thirty-seven Thousand Dollars for the  
5 year nineteen hundred sixteen; said sums to be expended  
6 under the direction of trustees of juvenile institutions, for  
7 maintenance of said school.
