RESOLVE, in Favor of the State School for Boys at South Portland for Permanent Improvements and Insurance.

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor  
2 of the State School for Boys at South Portland, the sum of  
3 Two Thousand Dollars for the year nineteen hundred fif-  
4 teen, and the sum of One Thousand Dollars for the year  
5 nineteen hundred sixteen; said sums to be expended under  
6 the direction of the trustees of juvenile institutions, for per-  
7 manent improvements to property, and insurance. •
