RESOLVE, for the Permanent Improvement of Buildings and for Increeasing Water Supply at the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in

- 2 favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at Hallowell
- 3 the sum of Two Thousand Dollars for the year nineteen
- 4 hundred fifteen and the sum of Five Hundred Dollars for
- 5 the year nineteen hundred sixteen; said sums to be expended
- 6 under the direction of the trustees of juvenile institutions for
- 7 permanent improvement of buildings and increasing the
- 8 water supply of said school.
