IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Set Off a Part of the Town of Centerville and
Annex the Same to the Town of Northfield.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All that part of the Town of Centerville in the County of
2 Washington, bounded and described as follows:—Beginning
3 at the northwest corner of the Town of Whitneyville and
4 northerly continuing the same course as the west line of
5 Whitneyville to the Town of Northfield; thence easterly by
6 the south line of said Northfield to southeast corner of said
7 town; thence southerly by the easterly line of said Center-
8 ville to the northeast corner of the town of Marshfield;
9 thence westerly by the north lines of said Marshfield and
10 Whitneyville to place of beginning, is hereby set off from

11 said town of Centerville and annexed to the Town of North-
12 field.

The enclosed action is to set off that portion of Centerville known as the Gore Lot, and it is understood that the said town is agreeable, also Whitneyville.
