STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 2 of Chapter 51 of the Private and Special Laws of 1840, relating to Franklin County Agricultural Society.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

By adding after the word "Franklin," in the third line of 2 said section 2, the following words, and the towns of Mt.

- 3 Vernon and Vienna in Kennebec county,' so that said sec-
- 4 tion as amended will read as follows:
 - 'Sect. 2. Be it further enacted, that said society be, and
- 6 hereby is established within the county of Franklin and the
- 7 towns of Mt. Vernon and Vienna in Kennebec county, and
- 8 may take and hold property, real, or personal, to an amount,

9 the annual income of which shall not exceed three thousand 10 dollars, to be applied exclusively to the advancement of 11 agriculture and the mechanic arts connected therewith.'
