STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to provide for the care and maintenance of Mt.
Desert Bridge, in the Town of Trenton, in the County of
Hancock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The towns of Eden, Mount Desert, Southwest
2 Harbor, Tremont and Trenton, assisted by the County of
3 Hancock, shall bear the expense of keeping the Mt. Desert
4 Bridge in the Town of Trenton in repair and employing a
5 draw tender. The cost of maintaining said bridge and em-
6 ploying a draw tender shall be borne by the county and
7 towns as follows: The County of Hancock shall pay \$300
8 annually, and the said towns shall pay the balance of the ex-

9 pense in the following proportions: Eden, five-tenths; Mount
10 Desert, two-tenths; Southwest Harbor, one-tenth; Tremont,
11 one-tenth; Trenton, one-tenth. The amount so to be paid
12 by each of said towns shall be computed and fixed by the
13 county commissioners of said county and said several
14 amounts shall be added to, included in, and become and be
15 a part of the county tax annually assessed against said
16 towns.

Sect. 2. The county commissioners of said county of Han-
2 cock shall have charge of said bridge and employ a suitable
3 draw tender and keep said bridge in repair.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect in accordance with the
2 constitution whenever by purchase, gift or otherwise the
3 said Mount Desert Bridge is made a free bridge.
