STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT authorizing municipal officers of towns to obtain road
Material.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

The municipal officers of any city, town or plantation may
2 purchase, take over and hold for any city, town or planta-
3 tion for public use such materials and land as may be nec-
4 essary to provide a change of location or alignment of any
5 highway or to secure materials, including clay, gravel, sand
6 and rock, with the necessary ways and access thereto, for
7 the improvement, construction and maintenance of highways.
8 If the municipal officers of any city, town, or plantation are
9 unable to purchase such materials, or land with necessary

10 ways and access thereto, at what they deem a reasonable val-
11 uation, the county commissioners of the county wherein such
12 material or land is located shall, on petition of the municipal
13 officers, or interested parties, ascertain and determine the
14 damages in the same manner as provided by Statute for land
15 taken for highway purposes and all parties aggrieved by
16 the estimate of damages shall have like remedy as provided
17 by Statute for appraisal of damages for land taken by towns
18 for highway purposes.
