## STATE OF MAINE

AN ACT to amend section seven of chapter two hundred and twenty-two of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and nine relating to the Licensing of Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seven of chapter two hundred and twenty-two of 2 the public laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby 3 amended by inserting after the word "thereof" in the tenth 4 line the following: 'After the issuing of the warrant above 5 mentioned, the clerk of any city or town may issue a license 6 to the owner or keeper of a dog, on receipt of the sum required for license by section three and in addition thereto 8 the further sum of two dollars to pay the officer's fee on 9 said warrant,' so that said section as amended shall read as 10 follows:

'Sect. 7. The mayor of each city and the municipal offi-12 cers of each town or plantation shall annually within ten 13 days from the first day of May issue a warrant, returnable 14 on the first day of June following, to one or more police 15 officers or constables, directing them to proceed forthwith 16 either to kill or cause to be killed all dogs within said city. 17 town or plantation not licensed, collared or enclosed accord-18 ing to the provisions of this act, and said constable or police 19 officer shall or any other person may enter complaint against 20 the owner or keeper thereof. After the issuing of the war-21 rant above mentioned the clerk of any city or town may 22 issue a license to the owner or keeper of a dog on receipt 23 of the sum required for license, by section three, and in 24 addition thereto the further sum of two dollars to pay the 25 officer's fee on said warrant. On the first day of June, 26 the mayor of cities and the municipal officers of towns and 27 plantations shall issue to one or more police officers or con-28 stables a warrant returnable on the first Monday of the 29 following February, directing said police officers or con-30 stables to kill or cause to be killed forthwith any dog not 31 licensed or collared according to the provisions of this act 32 and to enter complaint against the owner or keeper thereof.
