STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT relating to Village Corporations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Village Corporations chartered by the legislature may take 2 and hold lands by devise or gift in trust for play ground 3 or park purposes, and may expend not exceeding ten per 4 cent of the money apportioned such Village Corporation, 5 under its charter, for the improvement and care of such 6 land.
