AN ACT to amend Section 11 of Chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes relating to Steam Riding Galleries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eleven of chapter thirty-one of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of said section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

‘Sect. 11. Municipal officers of any town upon the pay-
5 ment of a sum not exceeding fifty dollars shall grant a
6 license to operate or run a merry-go-round or steam riding
7 gallery in their town, but the license shall not exempt the
8 operator from complaint to the supreme judicial court for
9 maintaining a nuisance under section eight of chapter twen-
10 ty-two of the revised statutes.’
