AN ACT to amend, revive and extend the charter of the Stratton  
Water Company.

---

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section one of chapter three hundred and forty-  
2 two of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and  
3 nine is hereby amended by striking out the names "O. M.  
4 Blanchard, Allen Blanchard, Royal W. Blanchard and B.  
5 Blanchard" in the first and second lines and inserting in  
6 place thereof the following names: 'O. Blanchard, Merle  
7 Blanchard, Cecil Blanchard and B. E. Blanchard,' so that  
8 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 1. O. Blanchard, Merle Blanchard, Cecil Blanchard, B. E. Blanchard and Ralph Blanchard, with their associates and successors, are hereby made a corporation under the name of Stratton Water Company, for the purpose of supplying the inhabitants of Stratton village in the town of Eustis with suitable water for industrial manufacturing, domestic, sanitary and municipal purposes, including the extinguishment of fires, with all the rights and privileges, and subject to all the liabilities of similar corporations under the laws of this state.'

Sect. 2. The rights, powers and privileges of the Stratton Water Company, which were granted by chapter three hundred and forty-two of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nine, are hereby revived and extended for two years. The persons named in the original act and those substituted by section one of this act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the same manner, and for the same purposes as specified in said act.
