STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to build and repair a Dyke in the Town of Milbridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Joel G. Gay, B. C. Perry, Jasper Wyman, William M. 2 Blood, their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby 3 authorized to build and maintain a good and sufficient dyke, 4 at Back bay in the town of Milbridge, to commence at a 5 point on the west side of Grain point, so called, and to ex-6 tend over tide waters across the creek there situated to land 7 of Alonzo Fickett in shore of the site of the old dyke for-8 merly built across said creek by the grantors of said Gay 9 and others, and to repair and maintain said old dyke.
