

STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, appropriating money in favor of maintaining navigation on the Upper and Lower Richardson Lake.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of one hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred 3 fifteen, and one hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred dred sixteen, for the purpose of maintaining lights along 5 the Narrows connecting the Upper and Lower Richardson 6 lake.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

That there was appropriated the sum of one hundred dollars for lights in the Narrows in 1909-1910-1911-1912. The Narrows are in the Lower Richardson lake. That the lake at this point is very narrow, and that boats carrying mail and passengers after dark, are in danger if lights are not displayed, as the water is very deep.
