Senate Amendment A to Senate Doc. No. 153.

Section 1 of Senate Document 153 is hereby amended by striking out all of the same and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

'Section 1. All persons in the employ of the State of Maine 2 or any department thereof whose work is performed in the 3 State House, and whose salaries or wages are paid out of 4 the treasury of the State of Maine, except officials, technical 5 and professional employees of any state department or com-6 mission, persons whose salaries are fixed by law, and employees working under the superintendent of Public Build-

8 ings shall for the purposes of their employment and for the 9 determination of their salaries or wages be grouped into 10 four classes to be known as chief clerks, clerks, stenogrant phers and copyists.'
