STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to ratify, confirm and make valid the proceedings of
the First Congregational Parish at Kittery, Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All the proceedings of the First Congregational
2 Parish of Kittery, a Parish duly incorporated under the laws
3 of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, are hereby ratified,
4 confirmed and made valid.

Sect. 2. The said First Congregational Parish of Kittery
2 is empowered and authorized to unite with the Congrega-
3 tional Church of said Kittery as a duly incorporated body
4 under the title of the Kittery Point Congregational Church
5 whenever at a duly called meeting of the said Parish two-

6 thirds of the members present and voting shall declare them-
7 selves in favor of such union.
