STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of an appropriation to complete the historical record of Maine men serving in the United States Navy during the War for the suppression of the Rebellion, 1861-1865.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000)

2 for the year nineteen hundred and fifteen is hereby appro
3 priated, to be expended under the direction of the Governor

4 and Council, to complete the historical records of residents

5 of the State of Maine who had service in the United States

6 Navy during the War for the suppression of the Rebellion,

7 eighteen hundred and sixty-one to eighteen hundred and

8 sixty-five. Any portion of the appropriation remaining un
9 expended on December thirty-one, nineteen hundred and

10 fifteen shall be carried forward and be available for ex
11 penditures in the year nineteen hundred and sixteen.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

One thousand dollars (\$1000) was appropriated by the Legislature in 1913 for the purpose of procuring and compiling for the records of the Adjutant General's office the service records of men from Maine who served in the United States Navy during the War for the Suppression of the Rebellion, 1861-1865, but owing to circumstances it was impossible to accomplish the work during the years 1913-1914. The appropriation, therefore, was not used and reverted back to the treasury. This resolve asks merely for a continuation of the appropriation and it is thought the work may be completed within the next two years.
