STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to repeal the provisions of Chapter eighty-seven of the Special Laws of nineteen hundred and three, relating to the taking of lobsters within three miles of the islands of Matinicus and Criehaven.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The provisions of Chapter eighty-seven of the Special Laws 2 of nineteen hundred and three, are hereby repeald.
