STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT To provide for the Construction of Sidewalks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Road Commissioners in towns having a

- 2 valuation of not less than three hundred thousand dollars,
- 3 and not more than two million dollars shall expend an
- 4 amount not to exceed five per cent of the amounts annually
- 5 raised and appropriated for ways and bridges in the con-
- 6 struction and repairs of sidewalks and cross walks; except
- 7 that such towns may vote to raise and expend a larger sum
- 8 for such purpose.

Sect. 2. Said walks shall be constructed and maintained in 2 that part of the town known as the business and compact 3 part thereof.
