STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of rebuilding a bridge in the town of
Cutler.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of five hundred dollars for the purpose of aiding in
3 rebuilding the "Turner Bridge" so called, in the town of
4 Cutler, provided that there be appropriated by said town
5 of Cutler the sum of five hundred dollars for the same pur-
6 pose, and that any necessary cost above one thousand dollars
7 for rebuilding said bridge shall be borne by the town of
8 Cutler; the expenditure of all sums of money to be under
9 the supervision of the State Highway Commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge was destroyed in the early part of the winter by a heavy storm. The town of Cutler has about forty-five miles of State highway and several large bridges with only a valuation of \$161,192, and a tax rate of .028, without any manufacturing industries in the town.
