STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section ninety-three of chapter four of the Revised Statutes, relating to attendance at theatrical exhibitions by school children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ninety-three of chapter four of the revised statutes
2 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the follow-
3 ing clause:

‘Cities, towns and village corporations may adopt by-laws
5 and ordinances, with suitable penalties, regulating the attend-
6 ance at theatrical exhibitions, moving picture shows, and the
7 like during terms of school.’
