STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section one hundred fifteen of chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter one hundred six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred nine, as further amended by chapter one hundred eighty-six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred eleven and as further amended by chapter forty-five of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, relating to the appropriation for the support of the Normal and Training Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred fifteen of chapter fifteen of the re-
2 vised statutes as amended by chapter one hundred six of

3 the public laws of nineteen hundred nine, as further amend-
4 ed by chapter one hundred eighty-six of the public laws of
5 nineteen hundred eleven and as further amended by chapter
6 forty-five of the public laws of nineteen hundred thirteen,
7 is hereby further amended by striking out the words "eighty-
8 five" in the second and fourth lines thereof and substituting
9 therefor the word 'ninety' and by striking out the word
10 "thirteen" in the fourth line thereof and substituting there-
11 for the word 'fifteen,' so that said section when amended
12 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 115. For the support of the five normal schools and
14 Madawaska training school, the sum of ninety thousand dol-
15 lars is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred fifteen
16 and the sum of ninety thousand dollars is annually appro-
17 priated thereafter, to be expended under the direction of
18 said trustees, which sum the treasurer of state shall deduct
19 for said purpose from any school money raised for the sup-
20 port of common schools. The governor and council may,
21 from time to time, as they think proper, draw warrants
22 therefor on said treasurer in favor of said trustees.'

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

An increase in the appropriation for the support of the five state normal schools and the Madawaska training school is required to meet the additional needs of these schools through normal growth.
