AN ACT to change the name of Maine Industrial School for Girls, and to change the name of principal to that of superintendent.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The name of "Maine Industrial School for  
2 Girls" is hereby changed to that of "State School for Girls."

Sect. 2. The principal of the "Maine Industrial School  
2 for Girls" shall hereafter be designated as the superintend-  
3 ent, and wherever the word principal is used in connection  
4 with this school in any law, it shall be construed to mean  
5 under this act, the superintendent.
