STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to change the name of Maine Industrial School for Girls, and to change the name of principal to that of superintendent.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. The name of "Maine Industrial School for
2 Girls" is hereby changed to that of "State School for Girls."
Sect. 2. The principal of the "Maine Industrial School
2 for Girls" shall hereafter be designated as the superintend3 ent, and wherever the word principal is used in connection
4 with this school in any law, it shall be construed to mean
5 under this act, the superintendent.
