STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of rebuilding a bridge across the Dennys
River between the towns of Dennysville and Edmunds.

Resolved. That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) to aid in rebuilding
3 the bridge across the Dennys river between the towns of
4 Dennysville and Edmunds, county of Washington, provided
5 that there be appropriated by the said towns of Dennysville
6 and Edmunds in proportion to their respective valuations.
7 the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) for the same pur-
8 pose, both sums to be expended under the supervision of
9 the state highway commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge connects the two towns, and each town built one-half of the bridge. Both towns are poor, and have a high tax rate, and are not able to rebuild this bridge unless they do no work on the highways the coming year, and said highways are now in poor repair.
