STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, providing for the screening of Parker Pond in
Kennebec and Franklin Counties.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars
2 be and is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred
3 and fifteen for the purpose of screening Parker pond in
4 Kennebec and Franklin counties, to be expended under the
5 direction of the commissioners of inland fisheries and game,
6 when the balance necessary to erect said screen, as found
7 by said commissioners, shall have been raised by citizens
8 of Kennebec and Franklin counties and paid to the treas-
9 urer of state for this purpose.

Provided, further, that no part of this appropriation shall
11 be used for the maintenance of said screen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In order to improve the fishing in this pond, it is necessary to keep the same screened. The present screen at the outlet of said pond is unsuitable and, furthermore, a new dam is to be erected early in 1915, by parties owning the water privilege, at the outlet of said pond, and it will be necessary to install a new screen. The people interested feel that the state should assist in this matter, hence this resolve is introduced for the purpose of securing funds to aid in this work.
