STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Horse Shoe pond, in West Bowdoin College Township, so called, in the County of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

For a period of five years from the time this act takes ef-2 fect no person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of 3 fish at any time in Horse Shoe pond, in West Bowdoin Col-4 lege Township, so called, in the County of Piscataquis, from 5 the first day of October of each year until the thirtieth day 6 of June of the following year, both days inclusive, nor shall

7 any person have in possession at any time any kind of fish 8 taken in violation of any provision of this act.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine 10 of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars 11 and costs of prosecution for each offense; and in addition 12 thereto one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had 13 in possession in violation of any provision of this act.
