## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in portions of Rangeley Stream, Kennebago Stream and Little Kennebago Stream, in the county of Franklin and in the county of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
So much of chapter thirty-two of the revised statutes, as
a amended by chapter two hundred and six of the public laws
of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as prohibits fishing in that
portion of Rangeley stream from the sign at the old wharf,
near the head of said stream, down to the dam across said

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6 stream, in the county of Franklin, and in that portion of 7 Kennebago stream from Big Falls, on said stream, to Indian 8 Rock, in Oxford county and in Franklin county, and in that 9 portion of Little Kennebago stream from Little Kennebago 10 lake to its junction with Kennebago stream, in Franklin 11 county, from September fifteenth to September thirtieth of 12 each year, both days inclusive, in accordance with the spe-13 cial regulations applying to fishing in said streams now pro-14 vided in section two of said chapter thirty-two of the re-15 vised statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six 16 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, is here-17 by repealed.
