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AN ACT relating to the Clark Power Company.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The Clark Power Company, incorporated un-  
2 der the provisions of chapter two hundred fifty of the pri-  
3 vate and special laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, its  
4 successors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empow-  
5 ered to construct a dam across the Saco river at any point  
6 between the towns of Buxton and Dayton in the county of  
7 York upon lands now owned or hereafter acquired by said  
8 company, its successors or assigns, for the purpose of stor-  
9 ing water therein and to use the same for developing power  
10 for any and all purposes, and by means of such dam to flow  
11 any and all lands on said river or any of its tributaries.

Sect. 2. All damages sustained by reason of flowage, unless otherwise agreed upon, shall be determined according to the laws regulating flowage damages.

Sect. 3. Suitable sluice-ways for log driving purposes shall be constructed and maintained by said company, its successors or assigns.
