# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT relating to the Clark Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Clark Power Company, incorporated un2 der the provisions of chapter two hundred fifty of the pri3 vate and special laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, its
4 successors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empow5 ered to construct a dam across the Saco river at any point
6 between the towns of Buxton and Dayton in the county of
7 York upon lands now owned or hereafter acquired by said
8 company, its successors or assigns, for the purpose of stor9 ing water therein and to use the same for developing power
10 for any and all purposes, and by means of such dam to flow
11 any and all lands on said river or any of its tributaries.

- Sect. 2. All damages sustained by reason of flowage, un-2 less otherwise agreed upon, shall be determined according 3 to the laws regulating flowage damages.
- Sect. 3. Suitable sluice-ways for log driving purposes shall 2 be constructed and maintained by said company, its suc-3 cessors or assigns.
