STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to extend the powers of the Limerick Water and Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Limerick Water and Electric Company, a corporation 2 created and existing by virtue of chapter one hundred and 3 fifty-nine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and dred and seven and acts amendatory thereof and additional 5 thereto, is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire 6 by purchase, lease, merger or consolidation and to exercise 7 and enjoy after such purchase, lease, merger or consolidation all of the rights, privileges, franchises and property of 9 the Hiram Water, Light and Power Company and of any

10 persons, firms or corporations engaged, or authorized to 11 engage in the business of generating, selling or distributing 12 gas or electricity for lighting, heating and power purposes 13 in any of the towns named in its said act of incorporation 14 and acts amendatory thereof and additional thereto, upon 15 such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon by the 16 said Limerick Water and Electric Company and the said 17 Hiram Water, Light and Power Company or such persons, 18 firms and corporations, and said corporations, persons and 19 firms are hereby authorized and empowered to lease, sell 20 and convey their respective properties to the said Limerick 21 Water and Electric Company or to merge or consolidate 22 with the said company, provided that any such lease, sale, 23 conveyance, merger or consolidation shall be approved by 24 the Public Utilities Commission.
