STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend the charter and extend the powers of the Hiram Water, Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Section nine of chapter one hundred and eighty-2 four of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred
3 and nine is hereby amended by striking out the word "fifty"
4 in the second line of the said section and inserting in the
5 place thereof the words 'one hundred,' so that said section,
6 as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 9. The capital stock of this corporation shall be 8 twenty-five thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of 9 one hundred dollars each.'

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Sect. 2. The Hiram Water, Light and Power Company is 2 hereby authorized and empowered to exercise and enjoy all 3 of its corporate rights, powers and privileges in the towns 4 of Sebago and Naples in the county of Cumberland in ad-5 dition to the towns named in its act of incorporation and 6 acts amendatory thereof and additional thereto, provided 7 that it shall not have authority to sell or distribute electricity 8 in either of the said towns wherein any other person, firm 9 or corporation is engaged in the said business, without the 10 consent of such person, firm or corporation, or the approval 11 of the public utilities commission.

Sect. 3. This act shall not authorize the condemnation of 2 water powers or water rights in said towns of Sebago and 3 Naples.
