RESOLVE, in favor of purchasing a portrait of Major General Joshua L. Chamberlain, a former Governor of this State.

Resolved, That a sum not exceeding five hundred dollars
2 be and hereby is appropriated to be used in purchasing the
3 portrait painted by Joseph B. Kahill, of Portland, of Major
4 General Joshua L. Chamberlain, late of Brunswick, a for-
5 mer governor of this state, and one of Maine's distinguished
6 sons.

The portrait to be placed in some suitable place in the state
8 house under the direction of the governor and council.
