RESOLVE, in favor of the Nasson Institute, for maintenance  
and extension of its work.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hun-  
3 fifteen and one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hun-  
4 dred sixteen for Nasson Institute at Springvale, a vocational  
5 school for young women, for the maintenance and exten-  
6 sion of its work, the same to be expended by and under the  
7 direction of the trustees of said institute.



## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Nasson Institute is a vocational school for young women which offers to high school graduates a full two-year programme in Home Economics or Secretarial Studies.

Plans for the Institute were formulated in January, 1912. Ground for the building was broken in June, 1912. The first class was enrolled in temporary quarters in October, 1912. The Institute building was occupied and dedicated in January, 1913. Statistics which show the growth of Nasson are as follows:
