STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Trustees of Freedom Academy.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the

- 2 sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred
- 3 and fifteen and the sum of five hundred dollars for the year
- 4 nineteen hundred and sixteen, to be paid to the Trustees of
- 5 Freedom Academy, for equipment and repairs on Dormi-
- 6 tory and Recitation Hall.

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STATEMENT OF FACTS.

There is no building for indoor exercise. Therefore the pupils for the greater part of the year are deprived of a very important part of School life and are commencing to demand such a building.

The Dormitory and Recitation hall are much in need of painting inside and out, and as there is a deficit in the Academy funds there is nothing with which to make these repairs.

The laboratory equipment is deficient in many ways and for the reason as stated above it is impossible to make needed additions.
