#### STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Augusta State Hospital for renovating the second male wing of Stone Building.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum

- 2 of eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000) for the use of the
- 3 Augusta State Hospital for renovating the second male wing
- 4 of the Stone building of said hospital; said sum to be ex-
- 5 pended under the direction of the hospital trustees.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

There are only two wings which have not been renovated. They are in very bad condition, unsanitary and unsafe, having been used for many years for untidy patients, and it is desired that the second wing be renovated as soon as possible.
