STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, for the construction, equipment, service connections and furnishings of one brick building for a Central Kitchen and bakery at the Maine School for Feeble-Minded.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of twenty-five thousand dollars, for the year nineteen
3 hundred fifteen, and twenty-five thousand dollars for the
4 year nineteen hundred sixteen, to be used by the Maine
5 School for Feeble-Minded, for the erection, equipment,
6 service connections and furnishings of one brick building
7 for a central kitchen, bakery, and that any of the appropria-
8 tion for the year nineteen hundred fifteen remaining at the
9 end of said year may be available for the year nineteen
10 hundred sixteen; said sum to be expended under the direc-
11 tion of the hospital trustees.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The building to include a kitchen large enough to allow for future growth of the Institution, refrigeration for cold storage of meats, milk, butter, eggs, fish and vegetables; a central bakery; a general storeroom for supplies; and quarters for kitchen and dining-room employees.
