STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of aid for a survey for a bridge across
the Taunton River between the towns of Sullivan and Han-
cock, in the County of Hancock.

Resolved, That the State Highway Commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to inquire into the necessity of con-
3 structing a bridge across the Taunton River between the
4 towns of Sullivan and Hancock, in the County of Hancock;
5 cause a survey to be made to ascertain the most suitable
6 site for a bridge and the probable expense of erecting said
7 bridge; and that the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) be
8 and hereby is appropriated to defray the expenses of such
9 survey: provided, however, that there be paid by the towns
10 of Hancock and Sullivan, or otherwise, the sum of five
11 hundred dollars (\$500) for the same purpose. Provided

12 further, that any additional cost for said survey, above one
13 thousand dollars (\$1000), shall be borne by said towns of
14 Hancock and Sullivan; all sums to be expended under the
15 supervision of the State Highway Commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge is deemed a public necessity and will be convenient not only to the people living in its immediate vicinity but to the public at large. Before any appropriation is made by the State towards its construction, it is deemed absolutely necessary by the State Highway Commission that a survey for the bridge is made.
