**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN**

AN ACT authorizing municipal officers of towns to obtain
road material.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The municipal officers of any city, town or plantation may
2 purchase, take over and hold for any city, town or plantation
3 for public use such materials and land as may be necessary
4 to provide a change of location or alignment of any highway
5 or to secure materials, including clay, gravel, sand and rock,
6 with the necessary ways and access thereto, for the improve-
7 ment, construction and maintenance of highways. If the
8 municipal officers of any city, town, or plantation are un-
9 able to purchase such materials, or land with necessary ways

10 and access thereto, at what they deem a reasonable valua-
11 tion, the county commissioners of the county wherein such
12 material or land is located shall, on petition of the municipal
13 officers, or interested parties, ascertain and determine the
14 damages in the same manner as provided by statute for land
15 taken for highway purposes and all parties aggrieved by
16 the estimate of damages shall have like remedy as provided
17 by statute for appraisal of damages for land taken by towns
18 for highway purposes.
