STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE appropriating money for the construction of one brick dormitory for inmates at the Maine School for Feeble Minded.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of twenty thousand dollars, for the year nineteen hun-
3 dred and fifteen, and the sum of twenty thousand dollars,
4 for the year nineteen hundred and sixteen, for the use of
5 the Maine School for Feeble Minded, in the erection of one
6 brick dormitory for inmates, and that any of the appropria-
7 tion for the year nineteen hundred and fifteen remaining
8 unexpended at the end of said year, may be available for
9 the year nineteen hundred and sixteen; said sum to be ex-
10 pended under the direction of the hospital trustees.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This construction to include the erection, furnishing, and equipment of one brick dormitory building, to accommodate 70 inmates, or a total additional accommodation for 70 inmates. This building to include day-rooms and sleeping quarters, and rooms for school and industrial purposes.

At present there are over 175 applications for admission on the waiting list. The great majority of the applicants are urgent cases, and should be cared for as soon as proper accommodations can be provided.
