STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Augusta State Hospital for Nurses'
home.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of forty thousand dollars for the year nineteen dollars
3 for the year nineteen hundred and fifteen and twenty thou-
4 sand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and sixteen for
5 the use of the Augusta State Hospital for erecting and equip-
6 ping a nurses' home at said hospital, and any unexpended
7 balance for the year nineteen hundred and fifteen shall be
8 available for the year nineteen hundred and sixteen for said
9 purpose,—said sums to be expended under the direction of
10 the Hospital Trustees.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This resolve is to provide for the construction of a Nurses' Home, to accommodate fifty-three (53) nurses.

By placing the nurses in a pleasant home, the present living conditions, almost intolerable on the wards, will be overcome; desirable nurses would have some incentive to remain in the service; and additional room would be available for patients, by making the rooms on the wards, now used for nurses, into dormitories for patients.
