IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to restore the jurisdiction of Trial Justices in criminal offenses in the towns of Kittery and York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Trial justices in the towns of Kittery and York in the
2 county of York shall have concurrent jurisdiction with the
3 Yorkshire municipal court of all criminal offenses and vio-
4 lations of town by-laws in said towns.
