STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section II of Chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes relating to steam riding galleries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eleven of chapter thirty-one of the revised statutes 2 is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and 3 inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sect. 11. Municipal officers of any town upon the pay-5 ment of a sum not exceeding fifty dollars shall grant a 6 license to operate or run a merry-go-round or steam riding 7 gallery in their town, but the license shall not exempt the 8 operator from complaint to the supreme judicial court for 9 maintaining a nuisance under section eight of chapter twen-10 ty-two of the revised statutes.'
