STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT relating to Village Corporations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Village Corporations chartered by the legislature may take
2 and hold lands by devise or gift in trust for playground or
3 park purposes, and may expend not exceeding ten per cent
4 of the money apportioned such Village Corporation, under
5 its charter, for the improvement and care of such land.
