STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to authorize the construction of a Weir in the Tide waters of the Cobscook River in the town of Lubec.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. A. J. Small of Lubec, in the county of Wash-

- 2 ington, is hereby authorized to build and maintain a Weir
- 3 for Fishing purposes in the Tide Waters in front of land of
- 4 said A. J. Small of said Lubec, providing that said Weir
- 5 does not interfere with Navigation or the rights of others.

Sect. 2. The above mentioned Weir shall be located as

- 2 follows: Commencing on the shore of said A. J. Small's
- 3 land, and running in an easterly direction Eight Hundred
- 4 Feet more or less, to a Ledge on Cooper's Island (owned

- 5 by said A. J. Small) thence in a southeasterly direction
- 6 Three Hundred Feet more or less, thence in a southwesterly
- 7 direction Seventy-five Feet more or less, to a ledge where
- 8 the mouth of Weir will be located, thence up the shore of
- 9 said A. J. Small in a southwesterly direction One Hundred
- 10 and Seventy-five Feet more or less.
