STATE OF MAINE

*Ordered, the house concurring, that the Governor, with
2 the advice of the Council, appoint three commissioners, one
3 of whom shall be an attorney, whose duty it shall be to take
4 all necessary and suitable measures to ascertain the method
5 of said Hancock Mutual Fire Insurance Company in con-
6 ducting its business affairs, the amount of all money re-
7 ceived, and paid out, for what purpose, and by whom, the
8 amount of all its losses, and all expenses incurred by said
9 company, and by whom, from the date of its organization
10 to the date of its suspension of business by the appointment
11 of a receiver and to include all acts of said receiver. Said
12 commissioners to report the result of such investigation
13 to the Governor and Council, on or before the first day of
14 October A. D. 1915, and the sum of two hundred and fifty
15 dollars shall be, and the same is hereby, appropriated for
16 the purpose of said investigation.*
