STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section Fifteen of Chapter Fifteen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Section Two of Chapter Forty-eight of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Five and Chapter One Hundred Twenty-two of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen, in Relation to Accounting for an Expenditure of School Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifteen of chapter fifteen of the revised statutes as
2 amended by section two of chapter forty-eight of the public
3 laws of nineteen hundred and five and chapter one hun-
4 dred twenty-two of the public laws of nineteen hundred

5 and thirteen is hereby amended by striking out all after the
6 word "occurred" in the eleventh line, so that said section
7 when amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 15. No money appropriated by law for public
9 schools shall be paid from the treasury of any town, except
10 upon written order of its municipal officers; and no such
11 order shall be drawn by said officers except upon presenta-
12 tion of a properly avouched bill of items said bill of items
13 having first been approved by a majority of members of
14 the superintending school committee and certified by the
15 superintendent of schools. The unexpended balance of all
16 moneys raised by towns, or received from the State, for the
17 payment of wages and board of teachers, fuel, janitors' ser-
18 vices, conveyance or tuition and board of scholars, shall be
19 credited to the school resources for the year following that
20 in which said unexpended balance occurred.'
