STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Complete the Records in the Registry of Deeds in Androscoggin County.

Section 1. Upon the approval of this act the governor 2 shall appoint and commission some suitable person, who 3 after first being sworn to perform his duty under this act, 4 shall at once proceed to cause to be copied so much of the 5 records now in the registry of deeds for the counties of 6 Cumberland, and Lincoln, as relate to real estate in that por-7 tion of the present county of Androscoggin which was for-9 coln prior to the organization of said county of Androscog-10 gin, in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and fifty-11 four.

- Sect. 2. The copies shall be made on paper of the kind 2 and quality used for recording deeds in the registry of 3 deeds for said county of Androscoggin and shall be bound 4 into books corresponding in size and quality with those 5 now in use in said office, and shall be indexed in the form 6 known as ledger index, corresponding with that now used 7 in said office.
- Sect. 3. The copies shall be compared by the commission2 er, who shall certify to their correctness. When so certi3 fied and deposited in the registry of deeds for the said coun4 ty of Androscoggin, they may be used for any purpose the
 5 same as the original record, and copies of the record of such
 6 copies and certificates shall be admissible in evidence in all
 7 cases where copies of the original record would be admis8 sible.
- Sect. 4. Said commissioner shall purchase all supplies 2 and employ such clerical help as may be needed to advan-3 tageously forward said work and shall be accorded by the 4 registers of deeds for the several counties reasonable fascilities for the execution of the work without trouble or 6 expense to them.
- Sect. 5. Said commissioner shall receive compensation 2 for his personal services at a rate to be fixed by the gover-3 nor. He shall submit an itemized statement showing the 4 amount due him on account of his personal services, amount 5 paid for clerical help, paper, binding or other necessary exferences which shall be audited and paid by the commission-

7 ers of the said county of Androscoggin, who are hereby au-8 thorized to pay the same ou of any funds in the treasury of 9 said county not otherwise appropriated, or to raise the same 10 by temporary loan.
