AN ACT to enable the cities and towns of the State of Maine  
to appropriate money to aid in the erection of the Knox Me-  
morial Building.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

The cities, or any of them, of the State of Maine, through  
2 their municipal governments, and the towns, or any of them,  
3 of said State, may at any legal meeting called by a warrant  
4 containing an article for the purpose, appropriate such sum  
5 or sums as each of them may vote, to aid in the erection of  
6 a Knox Memorial Building, to be erected at Thomaston,  
7 Knox County, Maine.
